

James Braid 1870 - 1951

James Braid came to the golfing profession as a clubmaker, first in Scotland and then in England. He was the professional at Walton Heath and won the British Open five times from 1901 to 1910. He, Taylor, and Vardon were referred to as the Triumvirate of Golf in the early years of the 20th century.












